

Cascade Clamp

Cascade Clamps - Founded in Portland, Oregon in the year 1943, the Cascade Manufacturing Company started as a small machine store hiring just 4 people. Total sales for that particular year totaled 60 thousand dollars. The first recorded sales revenues involved the machining and assembly of stainless-steel pipe fittings, valves and other parts. Within 5 years of operation, the business had expanded to forty workers and their annual sales volume had risen to 330 thousand dollars. Nowadays, Cascade is amongst the top global makers within the material handling industry.

Manufacture and design of the company's very first hydraulic cylinder paved the way in Cascade's aggressive pursuit of better business possibilities. Over the last 60 years, the material handling business has developed into a very sophisticated field and Cascade has proudly performed a part in this development. Cascade at present continues to develop as the leader supplier of lift truck attachments and various related items. The company feels confident in their potential so as to continue to lead the way within the business by understanding customer's needs in the future and remaining aggressive in the international market.

Throughout the nineteen fifties, Cascade began to make, design, and advertise its hydraulic attachments. A brand new facility was built in the year 1956, to be able to house all the plant offices and operations in Portland, Oregon, which is still the company's present head office. Following fifteen years of business, total employees reached one hundred eighty employees and sales had reached practically two million three hundred thousand dollars.

The next production plant was built in the year 1959 in Springfield, Ohio. nineteen sixty marked Cascade's preliminary transfer into the international world of the material handling industry as the company established interest in Australia, the Netherlands and England.

In the year 1964, the business changed its name to the Cascade Corporation. Afterward in the year 1965, the business went public with a preliminary offering of two hundred thousand shares of common stock. Ever since then the business has expanded its manufacturing services throughout the continental US to the places Warner Robins Georgia to go along with its already existing plants in Springfield, Ohio and Portland, Oregon. Cascade products are made internationally due to many subsidiary operations. In 1994, a new facility was completed in Almere, the Netherlands which is Cascade's European control center. This plant is built to be the ultimate customer service centre.

Continuing to grow, Cascade expanded their product offering further in the year 1996 and 1997 with the dramatic acquisition of five companies, including the global best in blades, the Kenhar Corporation.
